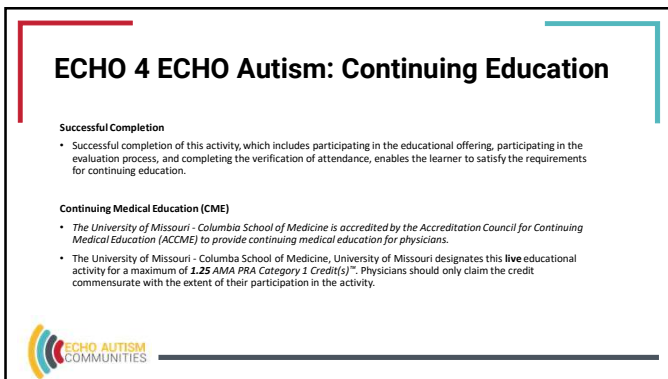

- Establish overarching expectations
- Provide clarity about the intentions of the program
- Drive the development of program objectives (i.e., specific steps/aims that determine what success looks like)
- Set the standard for program evaluation to determine performance
- Can be created for the short-term, medium-term and long-term

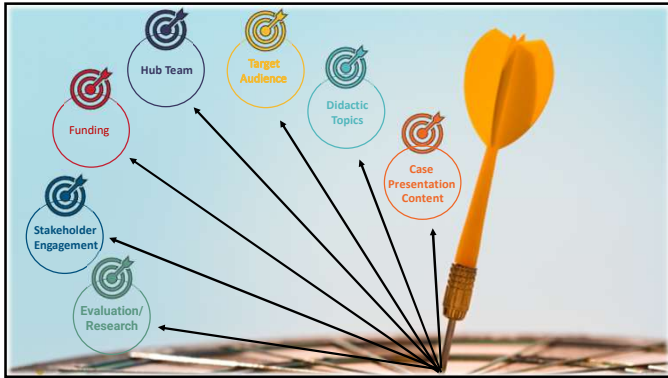
Goal

- **Specific:** State exactly what you want to accomplish (Who, What, Where, Why)
- **Measurable:** How will you demonstrate and evaluate the extent to which the goal has been met?
- **Achievable:** stretch and challenging goals within ability to achieve outcome. What is the action-oriented verb?
- **Relevant:** How does the goal tie into your key responsibilities? How is it aligned to objectives?
- **Time-bound:** Set 1 or more target dates, the "by when" to guide your goal to successful and timely completion (include deadlines, dates and frequency)

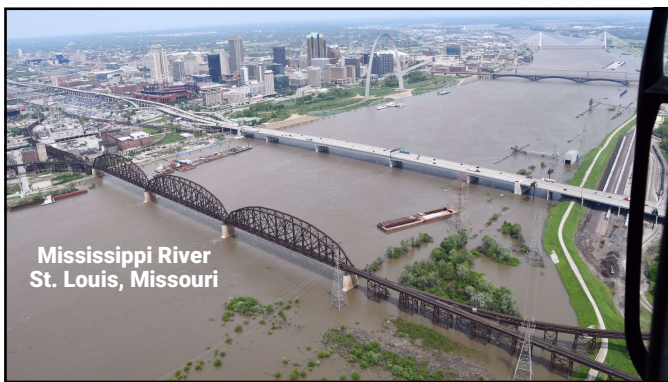

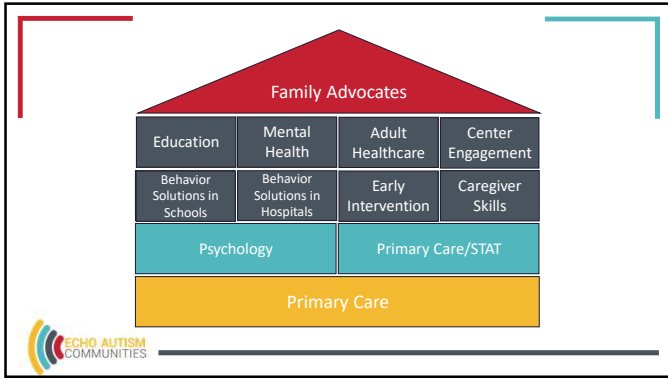
