- Three-digit number for any individual experiencing a mental health, suicide, or substance use crisis or any other emotional distress.
- Rapid access to a crisis care specialist 24/7 via call, text, and chat, and now VideoPhone.
- Available nationally, but up to each state to implement and support.


















Mobile Crisis Response

- Crisis response teams dispatched to wherever a person in crisis is located (a person's school, workplace, home, or other community location)
- Respond without law enforcement accompaniment when possible in order to support justice system diversion
- Resolve crises and provide care in the least restrictive setting possible
- Currently available statewide, but working with providers to enhance services throughout communities

Behavioral Health Crisis Centers

- A trauma-informed setting as an alternative to jails or the emergency room for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis
- Offer linkages to community resources and treatment
- Law enforcement drop-offs for bringing in individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis
- Goal to divert individuals from unnecessary jail, prison, or ER/ED visits
